A	I am not. My doctor doesn't think I'm ready to go back yet.
Q	Since the accident, what are your physical limitations? What are you not able to do now that you used to do before the accident?
A	Well, I used to coach my son's soccer team, and I'm not able to do that now. I used to help my wife with the yard work. I'm not able to do that at this time.
Q	Your wife does that now; is that right?
A	That's right.
Q	I understand she also hires a neighbor to do the yard work; is that true?
A	That's correct.
Q	All right. Do you plan on going back to work soon?
A	As soon as my doctor releases me.
